
Upon Motion of counsel, and for good cause shown, this Court has determined that the services of a jury consultant to provide consulting services are appropriate, necessary, REASONABLE and CONSTITUTIONALLY required in this case. The Court finds that these services are necessary to ensure the constitutional rights of the Defendant are properly protected for the specific reasons stated in the attached defense Motion, which is incorporated by reference.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Defendant, Shawn Anthony Mullins, be permitted to further employ the services of Margie Fargo, M.A., a jury consultant with offices in Alexandria, Virginia, to perform services on behalf of Defendant Mullins in the above numbered and captioned case. Ms. Fargo is authorized to proceed under the following terms and conditions:


1. Ms. Fargo shall be compensated at the rate of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per hour for up to 70 hours for reviewing questionnaires and the jury selection process.
2. Ms. Fargo shall be compensated at the rate of \$75.00 per hour for up to 10 hours of travel.

3. Ms. Fargo shall be compensated for up to \$2,500.00 for additional expenses including hotel, per diem, airfare and car rental.
